DIRECTIONS

If you are coming from the east...

- 1. Take Dodge past 52nd Street and Happy Hollow until right before the street light that is approximately 60th Street (unmarked).
- 2. Keep right and get into the "turn lane" on the right that allows you to go left from Dodge into the University entrance at that stop light. (Note the "Turn right to go left" sign right after the pedestrian bridge.)
- 3. After you go through the intersection and enter the University, take your first right onto University Drive North.
- 4. You will pass 5 buildings and 1 stop sign.
- 5. Take a left into Parking Lot E, right before the Criss Library (big, long windows on the top floor).

If you are coming from the west...

- 1. Turn right on 67th Street
- 2. Take your first left onto University Drive North

- 3. Pass the Durham Science Center and a stop sign
- 4. After the next building, the Criss Library (big, long windows on the top floor), take a right into Parking Lot E



Visitors of the CEC are welcome to park in lot E. If a parking stall is unavailable in Lot E the parking attendant will issue a 'Visitor Permit' and guests may park on any surface lot with this special permit. Overflow will also be re-directed to Lot T (East Parking Garage).

Lot D has been designated for overflow parking (when reserved in advance) to be used as needed for special events. Lot D connects to Lot E via a ramp and gate, if available for your use the parking attendant will direct guests to park in this lot
