Plans to convert the pond (mud hole) at Audubon Prairie to wetlands. Nebraska Game and Parks will look at the area and advise for making wetlands. They will get rid of the goldfish and introduce native fish. Wachiska Audubon is doing a write-up on our prairie on their website.

Glenn was alerted the Allen Hills easement property came up for a tax sale because the taxes had not been paid. Anne contacted her brother who is president of the Allen Hills Homeowners Association. He paid the back taxes and completed the transfer of tax payment to the homeowners association so this will not happen again.

8) Christine

Christine has been talking to Wachiska about strategic planning for the prairies. She would like to set up a board meeting with them at the prairie so we can work with them to plan the future of our prairie. Mark Brohman is the prairie director for Wachiska.
